What is the Convergence Summit?

The National Ecological Observatory Network (NEON) Convergence Summit is a highly interactive, in-person working conference that brings together an interdisciplinary group of researchers motivated to explore innovative ways NEON data, samples, and infrastructure can advance continental-scale biology. Over three days, participants will engage in dynamic discussions and collaborative activities designed to spark ideas and products, culminating in the co-development of impactful research outputs.

What to Expect

The Summit kicks off with a day of visionary thinking, featuring engaging speakers, peer-to-peer dialogue, and facilitated exercises that explore the future of continental-scale biology. Days two and three are dedicated to hands-on collaboration in working groups, each focused on creating a specific product that leverages NEON resources.

Potential products resulting from the Summit include:

- White papers/Scientific manuscripts
- Funding proposals
- Derived data products
- Predictive approaches, computational or surrogate models, digital twins
- Software/App development
- Curricula/Tutorial development
- Public-private partnerships

Each working group will leave the event with a clear goal and an actionable plan to move their product forward.
